This position will initially work on the Joint Venture Accounting team, reporting to the Supervisor, Production & Joint Venture Accounting.

Initial Joint Venture Accounting Responsibilities:

- Review and analysis of both operated and non-operated joint venture billings, verifying service fees are in accordance with joint venture agreements.
- Preparation of A/R reconciliations and collections.
- Review A/R balances for risky partners, prepare statements for bankrupt/delinquent partners, and work with their Court assigned receivers on collections.
- Coordinate monthly cheque runs monitoring both A/P and A/R accounts.
- Process deposit entries.
- Preparation and analysis of A/P and A/R quarterly reports and write offs.
- Ad-Hoc reporting, streamline processes, and any assigned special projects.
