### Senior Financial Analyst

- Primary liaison with Surge's external auditors
- Responsible for determining the appropriate IFRS accounting treatment for complex transactions and implementing new or amended IFRS standards
- Preparation of materials for Board packages
- Preparation of other public documents such as the AIF, prospectus filings and press releases
- Research and implementation of changes to securities regulations and review of securities filings
- Lead the design of internal controls over financial reporting (CSOX) and provide internal oversight

- Preparation of quarterly and annual tax provisions and the annual tax return
- Tax forecasting, planning and research
- Other tax compliance requirements
