Production Accountant

Reporting to the Supervisor, Production & Joint Venture Accounting, the successful candidate will be part of a skilled team responsible for handling all aspects of the property accounting cycle. Key responsibilities include full cycle production and revenue accounting for Saskatchewan Operated and Non-Operated properties.

Additional Responsibilities:

- Gather and analyze monthly production data and confirm pipeline deliveries
- Analyze revenue and royalties and submit volumetrics, SAF/OAF, SK oil valuation and other related reports to Petrinex to ensure compliance
- Maintain good relationships with key stakeholders such as Field Operations, Engineering and Government agencies to effectively report on assigned properties
- Communicate sales splits and generate volumetric, Crown, ORR and Freehold reports
- Upload and enter production data into Metrix
- Book and analyze revenues, royalties and processing charges on a monthly basis
- Ensure government requirements are met on EPAP & CAI
- Respond to internal and external queries in a courteous and timely manner

Qualifications include:

- Minimum 5 years of oil and gas production accounting experience in Alberta & Saskatchewan
- CAPP certification
- Working knowledge of the Metrix production accounting system including set up and maintenance of marketing arrangements, royalties calculations, facility charges is essential
- Working knowledge of Qbyte FM, CS Explorer, PVR and Microsoft Excel would be a strong asset
- Excellent communication skills are essential to this role
- Team player who is willing and able to take on multiple tasks and effectively prioritize multiple deliverables
